

2008 Aquarium of the Pacific Site Location Fees:

All location fees must be paid to the Aquarium of the Pacific before production commences

*All fees subject to change depending on the nature of the film and crew size.

Large Film Crews	\$15,000 per day (six to ten hours) \$10,000 per half day (five hours or less)
Film Crews (20 or less)	\$7,500 per day (six to ten hours) \$5,000 per half day (five hours or less)
Student Films/ Independent Documentaries	\$1,000 per day (six to ten hours) \$500 per day (five hours or less)
Additional Days for Set-Up/ Tear-Down	\$1,000 per day
Large Still Photo Shoot	\$10,000 per day (six to ten hours) \$ 5,000 per half day (five hours or less)
Still Photo Shoot (10 or less)	\$5,000 per day (six to ten hours) \$2,500 per half day (five hours or less)

Staff Rate of Pay Per Hour:

Production companies are responsible for arranging the pay-roll of Aquarium staff members, and payment must be remitted in a timely manner. The Aquarium staff must be paid from the time he/she arrives until the entire film crew leaves or is relieved of duty by another Aquarium staff member.

If production is cancelled and Aquarium staff has already been assigned, it is your responsibility to notify the Aquarium marketing department at least 24-hours before the planned shoot schedule. If not, production company agrees to pay up to four hours minimum call-out to any personnel assigned.

\$75/hr per staff member

- On-site Marketing Personnel
- Senior Security Officer/Security Officer
- Animal Husbandry Personnel
- Dive Safety Officer
- Facilities/Life Support Personnel
- Audio/Visual Personnel

One-hour minimum required per each staff member assigned to the shoot. For shoots that run more than 15-minutes past an hour, a 30-minute staff rate of \$37.50 will apply. For shoots that run more than 15-minutes past the 30-minutes, the full-hour rate of \$75 will apply. For individual staff time over 8 hours per day, an overtime rate will apply (time and a half).
