OVERNIGHT CODE of CONDUCT

We look forward to having your child join us for the Aquarium of the Pacific Teen Overnight. Please take some time to read over and discuss the following guidelines for behavior with your child. We ask that both you and your child sign the bottom of this sheet and return it on the evening of the overnight.

1. I will keep my hands to myself (no hitting, pushing, kicking, biting, etc.).
2. I will respect and listen to educators at all times.
3. I will respect other children (no name calling or teasing).
4. I will follow directions and stay with educators at all times, I will not run ahead of staff.
5. For my safety, I will wear close-toed shoes at all times.
6. I will use appropriate language (swearing will not be tolerated).
7. I will alert an educator if there is a problem with another child so that the educators can help me have a good time.

To have a fun and safe experience at this overnight, I will do my best to follow these guidelines and I understand that if I cannot follow these rules I will lose privileges such as game time, tours, or even feeding animals behind-the-scenes.

Waiver, Release, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement

Waiver: For and in consideration of permitting (child's name) _____ to enroll and participate in activities and class instruction of the Aquarium of the Pacific, beginning on the _____ day of the month of _____, 2018, hereinafter called "The Activity", I, for myself, my heirs, personal representatives, or assigns, do hereby **release, discharge, waive and covenant not to sue** THE AQUARIUM OF THE PACIFIC, its officers, employees and agents from liability **from any and all claims including the negligence of The Aquarium of the Pacific, its officers, employees, and agents**, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death), and property loss arising from, but not limited to, participation in The Activity.

Assumption of Risks: I understand and acknowledge that participation in The Activity carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries. The specific risks vary from one activity to another, but the risks range from 1) minor injuries such as scratches, bruises and sprains 2) major injuries such as eye injury and loss of sight, joint or back injuries, heart attacks, and concussions to 3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death. **I have read the previous paragraphs, and I know, understand and appreciate these and other risks that are inherent in The Activity. I hereby assert that my participation in The Activity is voluntary, and that I knowingly assume all such risks.**

Indemnification and Hold Harmless: I, also agree to IDEMNIFY AND HOLD The Aquarium of the Pacific HARMLESS from any claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees brought as a result of my involvement in The Activity and to reimburse them for any such expenses incurred.

Severability: The undersigned further expressly agrees that the foregoing waiver and assumption of risks agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Photographic Release: I grant the Aquarium of the Pacific and those acting under its permission and on its authority, the right and permission to copyright, use, publish, display, produce, duplicate, sell, and distribute photographic, video or sound recording reproductions, portraits or pictures of me/my child and physical likeness, which may be included in whole, in part or in composite, for any art, advertising, commerce, business, trade, or any other lawful purpose. I understand that this use applies to segments of the above for public announcements, informational film clips, or other uses necessary to provide information or advertisement for the Aquarium of the Pacific.

Acknowledgment of Understanding: I have read this waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement, fully understand its terms, and **understand that I am giving up substantial rights, including my right to sue.** I acknowledge that I am signing the agreement freely and voluntarily, and **intend by my signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability** to the greatest extent allowed by law.

FREQUENTLY ASKED OVERNIGHT QUESTIONS

▪ **What do I need to bring?**

On the evening of the overnight, meet the Aquarium educators at the front circle of the Aquarium. You may remain inside your vehicle. Please have the following:

1. *Signed emergency contact and code of conduct card*
2. *Signed waiver*
3. *Any necessary medical release forms*
4. *Sleeping bag and pillow (We will be sleeping on the floor in a gallery. You may wish to bring a cot or air mattress for your comfort, but make sure that you bring only what **YOU** can carry!)*
5. *Pajamas, toothbrush, and other toiletries (sorry, no showers are available)*
6. *Closed-toe shoes*

- **What time AND where do I need to drop off and pick up my child?** Please drop your child off at the front circle of the Aquarium between 4:45 and 5:00pm. Pick-up will occur in the same place at 7:30 a.m.
- **Should I pack a meal for my child?** Please do not send your child with any food items. We will provide a pizza dinner, a light snack before bedtime, and a cereal breakfast. If your child has any food allergies, please let us know in advance so that we can make alternate arrangements.
- **Where will my child sleep?** Children will sleep on the floor of an Aquarium gallery, either near the Tropical exhibit or the sea otters. Boys and girls will be sleeping in different areas.
- **Who may pick-up my child?** Only those listed on the emergency contact card will be authorized to sign out your child at the end of the day. Please instruct any person picking up your child to bring either the placard given to you on the first day of camp, or a photo ID. Campers may not sign themselves out and therefore must be picked up by an approved person.
- **Do I have to pay for parking?** If you choose to park in the parking structure you will pull a ticket and use the automated system to pay for parking. Please do not leave your car unattended in the traffic circle or you are subject to receive a ticket from the city.
- **Can I reach my child by phone?** If for any reason you need to reach your child during the evening, you can contact Aquarium security at (562) 951-1733.
- **Can my child's participation in the overnight be discontinued?** To maintain a safe and fun environment for all participants, we reserve the right to dismiss a child for the following reasons:
 - Extreme discipline problems
 - Non-cooperation with staff, policies, or procedures
 - Running away from staff or activities
 - Repeated violation of the general rules
- **Where is the lost and found?** Lost and found is at the information booth. Our Security Department holds all lost and found items for 30 days and then donated.
- **What if my child needs to take medication?** Please give the medications to the camp educator with written instructions. You will also need to sign a waiver that the camp educator will have available when you drop off your child. Please **DO NOT** send medications with your child. Please see our Food Allergy Protocol if your child requires an Epi-Pen.
- **What if my child is sick?** For your child's comfort and for the health of the other students, please do not send your child to the overnight if they are sick. We will call you to pick-up your child if they become ill.
- **What if my child is injured?** A safe and fun experience is our top concern. However, if your child becomes injured, we will take necessary steps to ensure that your child receives the proper medical attention. In the event of injury, we will attempt to contact you first, then those on the emergency contact list.
- **My child has allergies. Can you accommodate my child?** Yes! Please see our Food Allergy Protocol on our website for more details. NOTE: You must fill out the additional paperwork in the Food Allergy Protocol in order to leave your child at the Aquarium with an EpiPen.

Please BRING your filled out Emergency Contact Card, your signed Code of Conduct and Waiver with you on the evening of your overnight!
