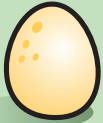

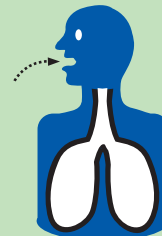

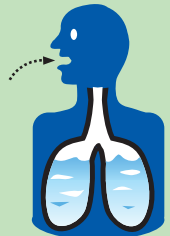

Sea otters lack blubber, but have a thick layer of fur to keep warm.



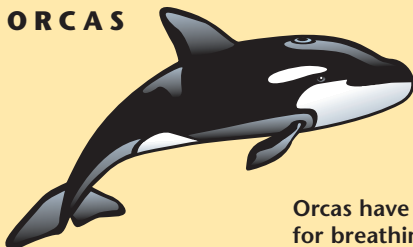
SEALS

Orcas have a single blowhole used for breathing at the surface.



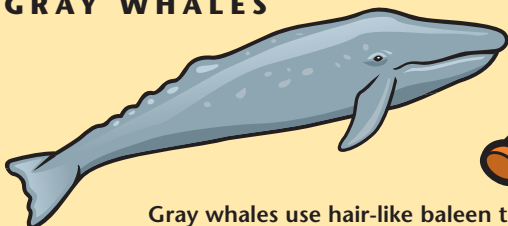
SEA LIONS



Sea lions are closely related to seals, but have earflaps and can sit up on all four flippers.



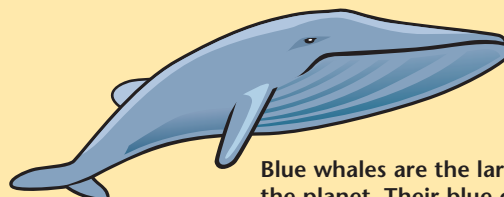
GRAY WHALES
