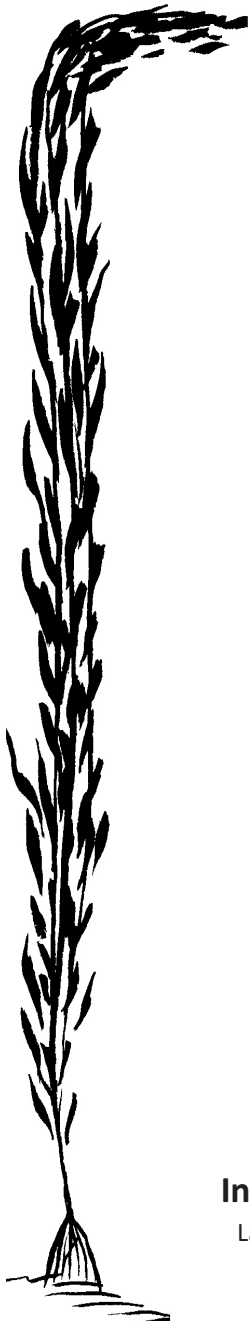


# Adventures in Science 2
