


Cereal Bird Feeder

Want to make a healthy bird snack to help you find more birds?



What you'll need:

- Unsweetened oat cereal like Cheerios (or other brands)
- Natural fiber string (burlap, jute, wool, cotton)
- Small object to act as a weight

How to build your bird feeder:

1. Cut a piece of string to the length of your choice.
2. On one end of the string tie your weight (could be a nut or bolt, or even a small rock).
3. Thread cereal through the string.
4. Tie a loop around the open end so the feeder can hang from a branch or hook.
5. Hang your bird feeder somewhere quiet where you can watch it from a distance!
