



A Day in Camp: Fish Fry



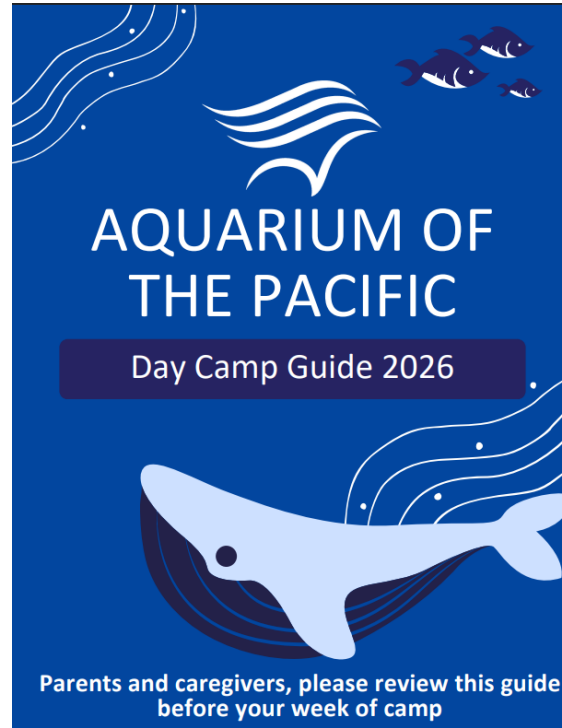
Welcome to Camp!

Camp Classroom



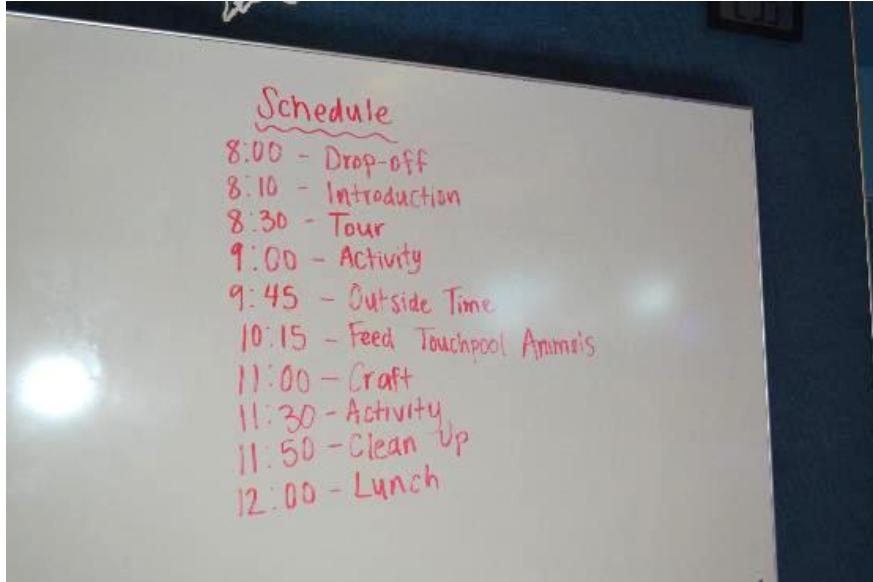
This is my camp classroom; my home-base during camp. Here we do activities, crafts and I eat my snacks.
