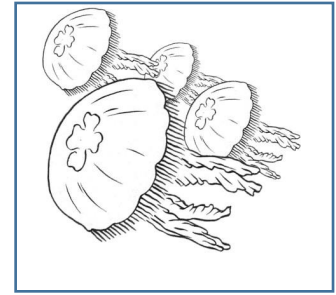
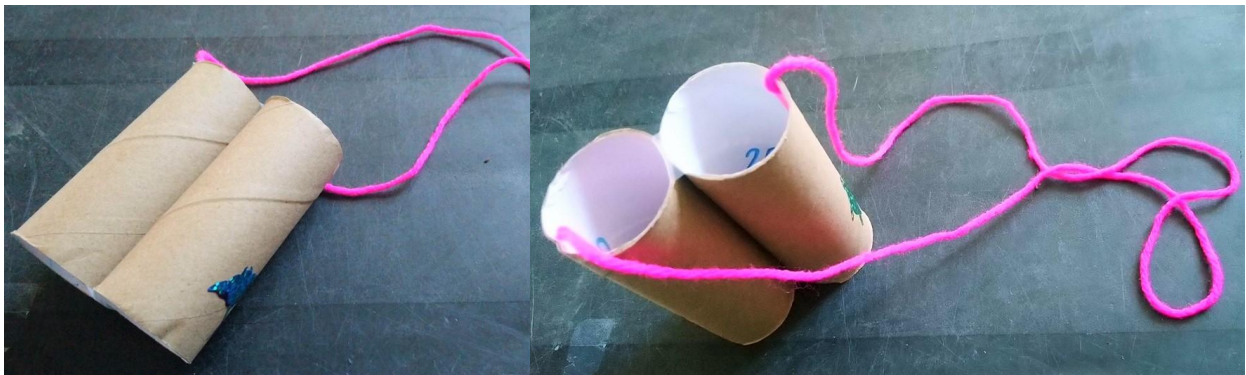


# Make your own binoculars!

1. Gather 2 empty toilet paper rolls. Or you can make your own paper rolls from regular paper.

3. Use markers, paint, or stickers to decorate your binoculars.
4. Optional: Attach string so you can wear your binoculars around your neck!
