
Squid Hat

Materials

- Paper (about four or five sheets)
- Coloring supplies



- Scissors
- Tape and/or stapler
- 1. For the body of the squid, cut out two pentagons using two sheets of paper (1 per sheet). Save two of the corners you cut off. These will be your fins!
- 2. Use another sheet to cut out two thick strips (for the headband) and two skinny strips (for the tentacles).
- 3. Using a fourth sheet of paper, make a zig-zag line with 8 points, about ¾ of the way down the paper, these will be your guide for your arms. Cut out 8 strips for arms. Use the remaining ¼ sheet of paper to cut out two ovals (for tentacle suckers) and two circles (for eyes).
- 4. Decorate and color your pieces!
- 5. Assemble the body pieces: Tape the fins to the inside of the body piece. Tape or staple the two body pieces together, leaving the bottom open to fit the headband.
- 6. Assemble the headband: Attach the eyes to the front of the headband. Next, attach two tentacle strips inside the front of the headband and add the oval suckers at the end. Add the arms around the inside of the headband. Make sure to leave room for your face to peek through!
- 7. Attach the headband to the bottom of the squid body.
